

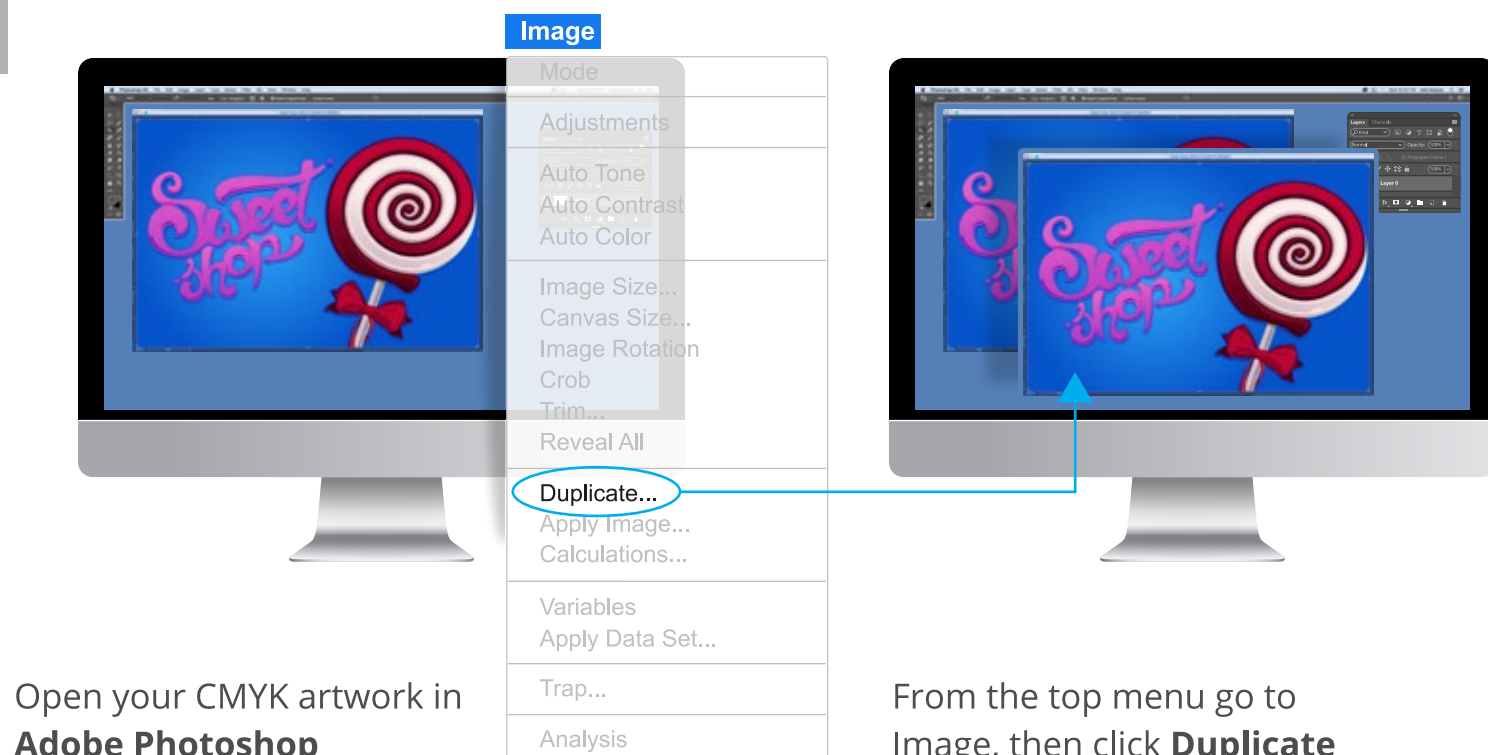
# Creating Multi-Level Raised UV files in Photoshop

Channel name must match the following: **RUV**

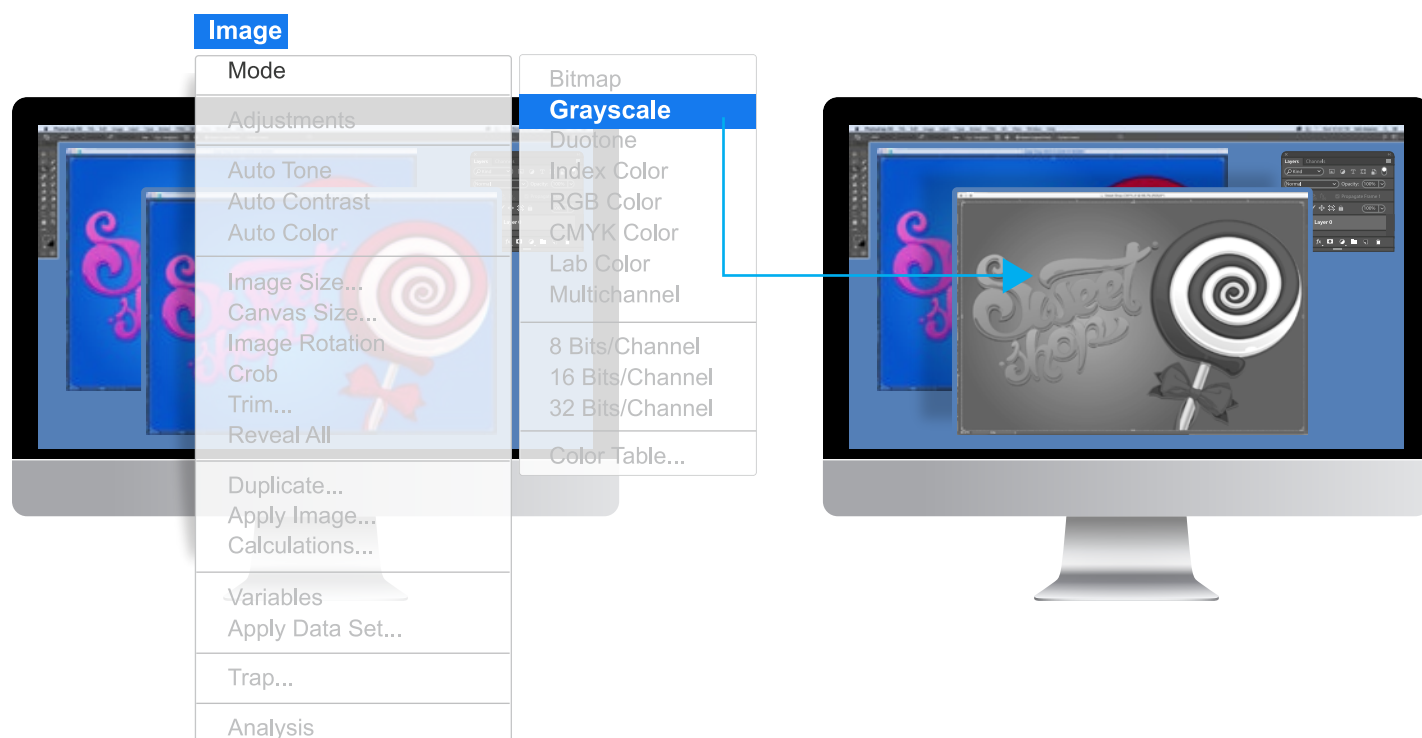


**Please note: If the channel name is incorrect, the order will be placed on hold and the file will be sent back via email for revisions.**

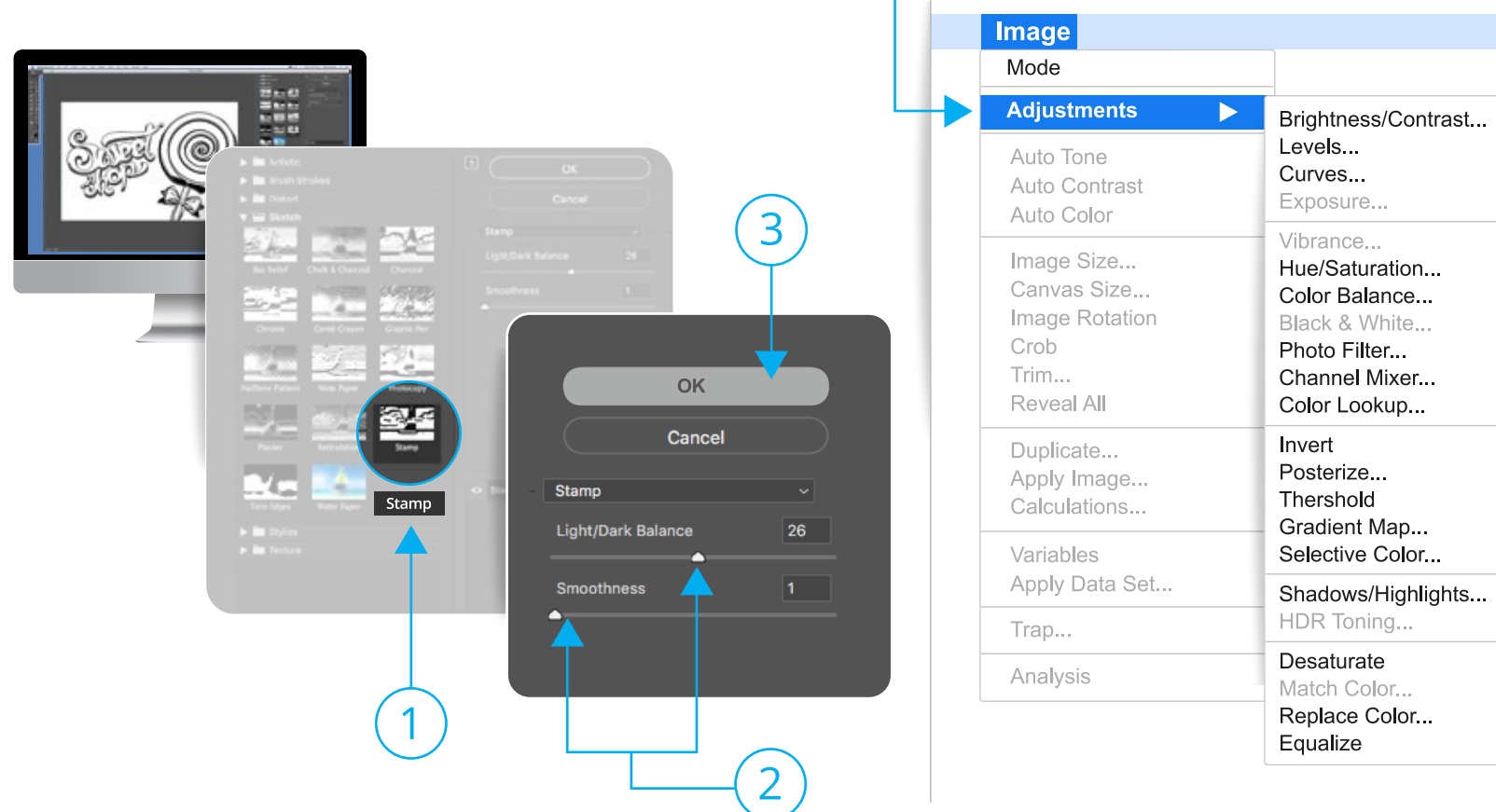

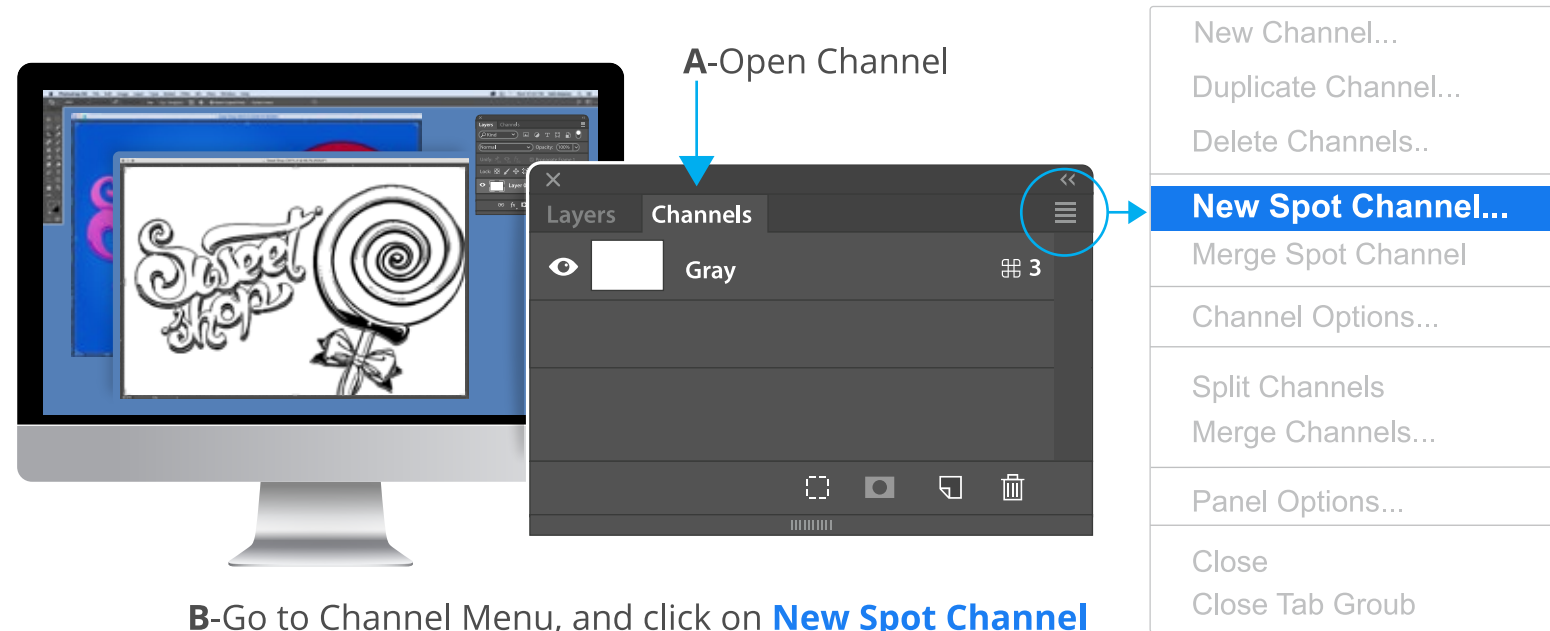

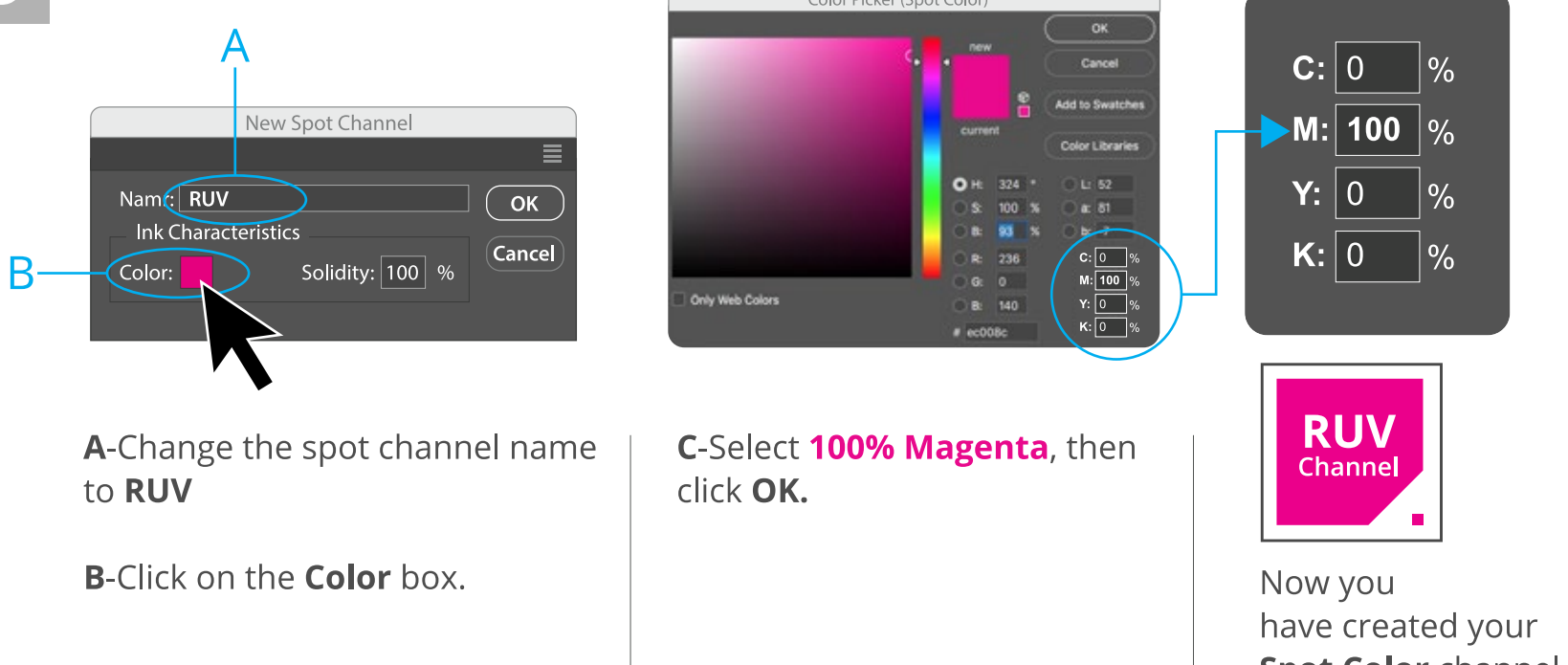
Apply **Filter Gallery Sketch filters** as desired. The darker the area, the more **RUV** it will have. White areas will have no **UV**. Modify as necessary using **Adjustment Tools** until desired **RUV** area is achieved.

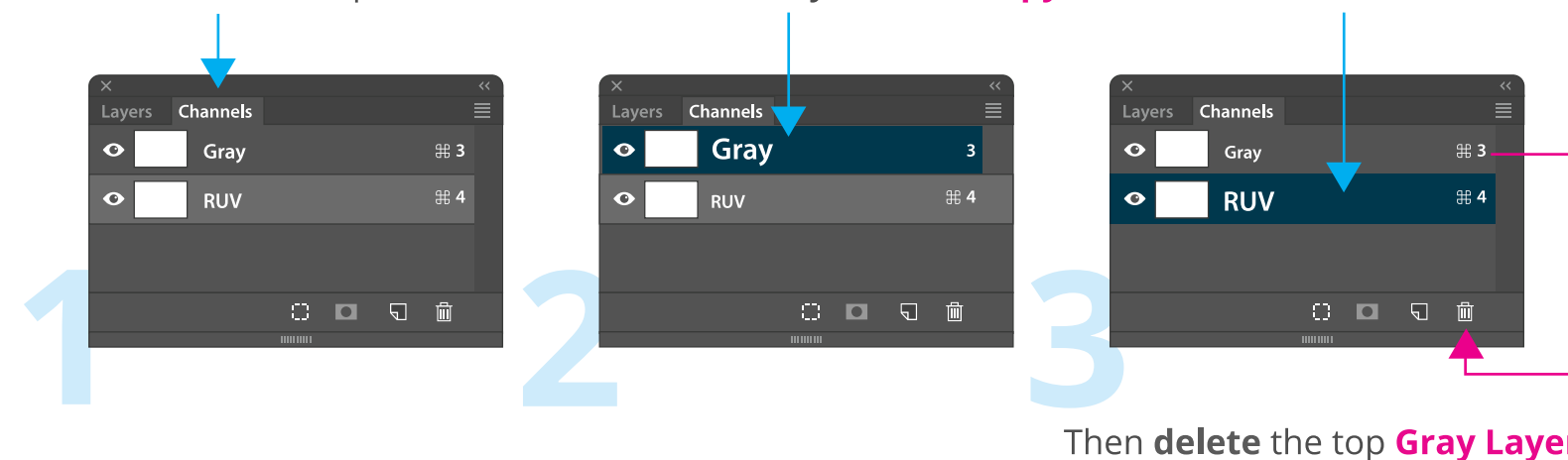

**Paste** in **RUV** channel

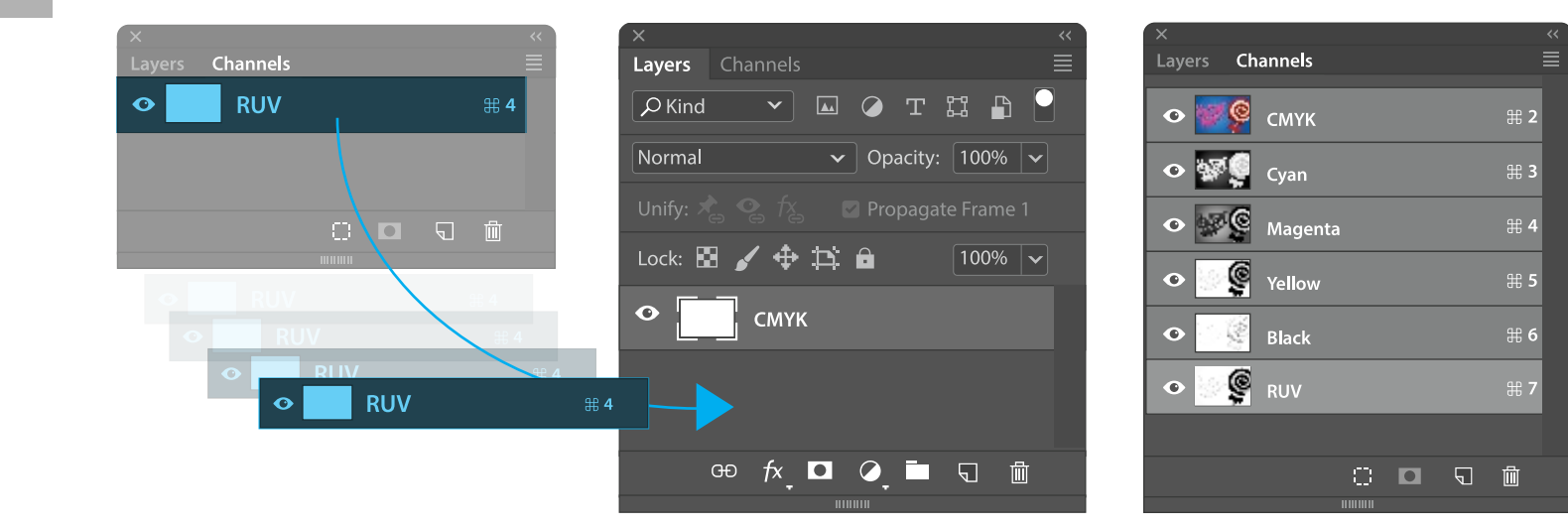

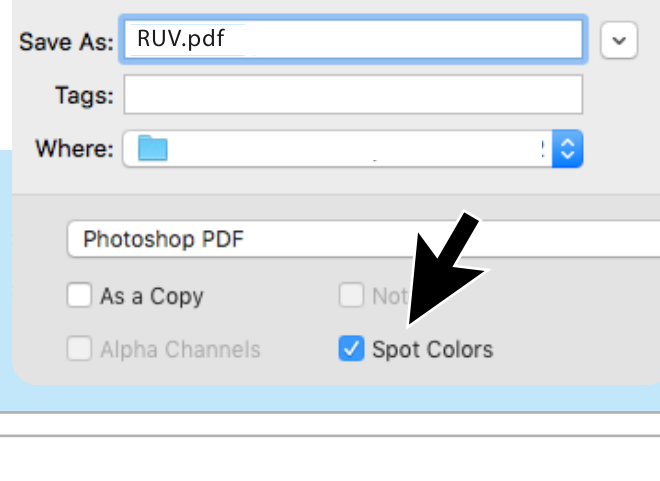
